On December 23, 2014, the Foreign Missions Board of Zoning Adjustment (FMBZA) of the District of Columbia, received the above-numbered application from Mary Carolyn Brown, of the Law Firm of Holland & Knight LLP, on behalf of the Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 1002, 206, and 350.6 of the Foreign Missions Act, to allow the installation of an accessory security screening structure and perimeter fence, partially located in public space, at an existing chancery in the SP-2 District at premises 601 New Hampshire Avenue, N.W. (Square 19, Lot 823).

The application will be considered by the Board in accordance with the requirements of the Foreign Missions Act, and any appropriate provisions of the Title 11 Zoning Regulations.
