SUBJECT: BZA Case No. 18970 – 2903 44th Street, N.W. (Square 1620, Lot 85)

APPLICATION

Pursuant to 11 DCMR §§3104.1 Nam Dinh Pham (the “Applicant”) seeks a special exception under §223 from the rear yard setback requirements under §§404.1 to allow the construction of an addition an existing single-family dwelling in the WH/R-1-A District at premises 2903 44th Street, N.W. (Square 1620, Lot 85)

RECOMMENDATION

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has reviewed the Applicants’ request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District’s transportation network. DDOT has no objection to the approval of the requested special exception.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. DDOT’s lack of objection to the zoning special exception should not be viewed as an approval of public space elements. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space requiring approval, the Applicants are required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT’s permitting process. The Applicant may refer to the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations and DDOT’s Design and Engineering Manual for specific controls of public space.
