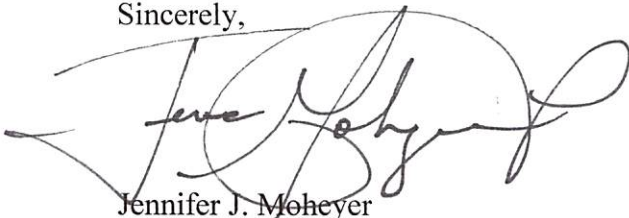
Dear Sir/Madam:

By way of introduction, my name is Jennifer J. Moheyer and I am the owner of 1003 Kenyon St NW in Columbia Heights, and former Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner for 1A-06. My neighbor, Mr. Gigi Mathews, is seeking a zoning variance to build an elevated deck on the rear of his property at 1000 Kenyon Street NW.

Mr. Mathews has provided me copies of the structural drawings and blueprints of his proposed work, which I have thoughtfully reviewed and considered with respect to its immediate impact upon our closest neighbors and its overall impact upon our block. I find it to be a positive addition to our block that reduces ground-level clutter and rodent harborage, and creates safe "elevated storage" behind Mr. Mathews' home, with little-to-no imposition upon the adjacent buildings.
