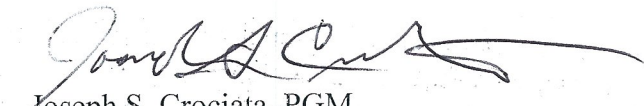
Re: ***Request for Variance***
