**APPLICATION**

Pursuant to 11 DCMR §§3104.1 Richard H. Broxton (the "Applicant") seeks a special exception under §223 from the open court requirements under §§406.1 to allow the construction of a two-story rear addition to an existing one-family dwelling in the R-3 District at premises 329 36th Street N.E. (Square 5021, Lot 8)

**RECOMMENDATION**

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has reviewed the Applicants' request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. DDOT has no objection to the approval of the requested special exception.

DDOT's lack of objection to the zoning special exception should not be viewed as an approval of public space elements. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space requiring approval, the Applicant is required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. The Applicant may refer to the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations and DDOT's Design and Engineering Manual for specific controls of public space. A summary can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Design Manual.
