On March 30, 2015, the Foreign Missions Board of Zoning Adjustment (FMBZA) of the District of Columbia, received the above-numbered application from Cary Kadlecek, of the Law Firm of Goulston & Storrs, on behalf of the **Apostolic Nuncio of the Holy See**, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 1002 and 206 of the Foreign Missions Act, to allow the installation of a perimeter security fence, partially located in public space, at an existing embassy in the D/NO/TSP/R-1-A District at premises 3339 Massachusetts Avenue N.W. (Square 2122, Lots 6, 16, 17, 20, 21, 804, and 809).

The application will be considered by the Board in accordance with the requirements of the Foreign Missions Act, and any appropriate provisions of the Title 11 Zoning Regulations.
