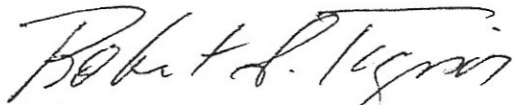
ORDERED that Defendant shall not communicate directly with Plaintiff in any manner (any communication must be in writing or by third party) and it is further

ORDERED that Defendant shall refrain from riding a bicycle on the sidewalk if Plaintiff is on the sidewalk and it is further

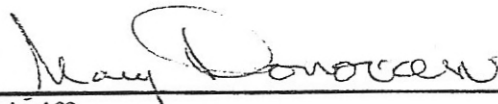
ORDERED that Defendant shall not enter on to the property assigned to 1363 Massachusetts Ave. S.E. for any reason and it is further

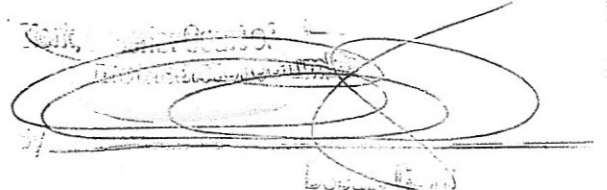

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

On May 4, 2012, the parties appeared for a hearing. Each party consented to a preliminary injunction – with the understanding that neither party admits that he or she has done anything wrong, and that each party agreed to this order in order to avoid the time and expense of litigation and to reduce the burden on the Court. The Court orders that, from the date of this order until the date of trial:

1. Mr. O'Donnell will not speak to Ms. Donovan, except to the extent necessary in connection with this case, including discovery, mediation, and court appearances.
2. Mr. O'Donnell will not enter onto the property located at 1363 Massachusetts Avenue, S.E., including the front lawn.
3. Mr. O'Donnell will not ride his bicycle on the sidewalk within 25 feet of Ms. Donovan.
4. Ms. Donovan will not contact Mr. O'Donnell's employer or the D.C. Bar, D.C. Bar Counsel, or any bar association regarding Mr. O'Donnell.
