I also finally met with Mr Daryl Adair, owner of the adjacent property on the left at 4924 Foote St NE. He fully supports the project and is trying out of his busy schedule to email me a letter stating that by tomorrow.

This case and case number 19040 were presented and discussed jointly at the ANC meetings which were elaborated on exhibit B of case number 19040

I attended the ANC monthly meeting on June 11th. Commissioners Holmes, Gaffney and Cosby were present. No one expressed an opposition to our variance request.

On Thursday August 27th, I received a call in the afternoon from Commissioner Holmes to come and join their executive board meeting in the evening. I could not attend with a very short notice on a day that I was at home sick. Mr Holmes accepted my absence and reassured me that they will discuss this case and try to wrap it up. No decision was made and I was again asked to attend the monthly meeting on Thursday September 10th. I attended the meeting, this time Commissioner Patricia Malloy in charge of 7C01 which includes our property was present.

After my presentation, Commissioner Malloy expressed immediate support for this project and said will issue a letter of support.

I have not been able to get in contact with Ms Malloy and left her voice messages to send me the letter. I then reached out to Commissioner Holmes about it and he expressed having taken action to request a delay of the hearing for both cases in order to discuss it again in their next executive board meeting.
