APPLICATION

Application of the Embassy of Kyrgyz Republic (the “Applicant”), pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3103.2, for variance from § 403.2 to allow the construction of a rear deck and patio extension in excess of the maximum allowable lot occupancy in the D/R-3 District at premises 2360 Massachusetts Avenue, NW (Square 2507, Lot 0050).

RECOMMENDATION

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has reviewed the Applicant’s request and determined that based on the information provided, this proposed project will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District’s transportation network. DDOT has no objection to the approval of the requested variance.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. DDOT’s lack of objection to this zoning variance should not be viewed as an approval of public space elements. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space requiring approval, the Applicant is required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT’s permitting process. The Applicant may refer to the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations and DDOT’s Design and Engineering Manual for specific controls of public space. A summary can be found in DDOT’s Public Realm Design Manual.
