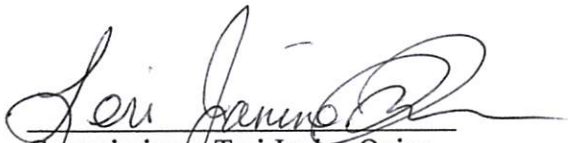

To All Interested Parties;

On October 20, 2015, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5E (ANC 5E) held their properly noticed, Public Monthly Meeting at Trinity Washington University. Notice was provided via posting on the ANC 5E website and via postings on the neighborhood listservs. The Applicant, O.A. Sulekoiki, was unanimously opposed by ANC 5E for their request for special exemption from Inclusionary Zoning requirements for their project at 2112-2126 3rd Street NE, within Single Member District 5E03.

Six Commissioners constitutes a quorum. Eight commissioners were present for this vote. A motion to not support this exemption was properly moved and seconded. The request to deny support was approved on a voice vote without objection. ANC 5E respectfully requests that the Zoning Commission deny the application referenced above.
