Ms. Dougherty, PSI has inspected and investigated this matter. We have met with the developer and will be issuing the appropriate citations and will be requiring Mr. Sulekoiki to remove the asphalt and return the specific area along Rhode Island Avenue NE to its original green space condition. This process cannot be done overnight, there are procedures that we must follow:

Meet with the developer

Instruct the developer on what is required Proceed with appropriate citations, if needed

Await the Administrative Hearing process and scheduling of a court date (or)

Meet with the developer

Instruct the developer on what is required Issue appropriate citations, if needed, and certified letter with a specific timeframe to remove said items.

In this case Mr. Sulekoike will be given 10 days to obtain the appropriate permits to remove the paved area and return to public space. When the citations and certified letter are prepared, I will be sure to notify you.

All of Mr. Boyer's other issues related to parking must be addressed with Department of Public Works, as they are the parking enforcement for the District.
