The Office of Foreign Missions of the United States Department of State has directed a chancery of a Foreign Mission to obtain BZA zoning relief for a project or use that is not provided as a matter of right for the zoning district.

A public hearing has been scheduled by the BZA on **Tuesday, October 20, 2015 at 9:30 am**, at the Jerrily R. Kress Memorial Hearing Room, One Judiciary Square, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C., 20001, concerning the following application:

Application of the Embassy of the Russian Federation, pursuant to 11 DCMR § 1002 of the Foreign Missions Act, to allow the construction of a security fence at an existing embassy in the R-5-D District at premises 2001 Connecticut Avenue N.W. (Square 2536, Lot 308).

WHY YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS NOTICE

The Zoning Regulations of the District of Columbia (Regulations) require the Office of Zoning (OZ) to refer Foreign Missions applications to your agency for review and comment when a chancery is located in an historic landmark or historic district and the use requires review and processing of new construction, demolition, or alteration pursuant to the Historic Landmark and Historic District Protection Act of 1978.

HOW TO FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THE CASE

In order to review exhibits in the case, follow these steps:

- Visit the OZ website at www.dcoz.dc.gov
- Under "Featured Services", click on "Case Records".
- Enter the BZA application number indicated above and click "Go".
- The search results should produce the list of case documents. Click "View Details".
- On the right-hand side, click "View Full Log".
- This list comprises the full record in the case. Simply click "View" on any document you wish to see, and it will open a PDF document in a separate window.
