- Photographs of the subject property;

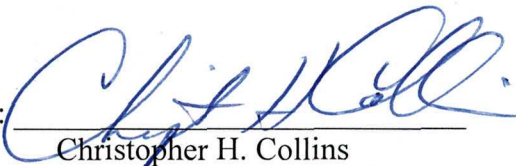
