I live in Vaughan Place, 3401 38th Street NW 521. I am against the site receiving zoning exemptions. I think the shelter is too large and needs to be scaled back to comply with existing regs, I am concerned about the realistic suitability of two large facilities sharing a small area (I.e. Police and a too large shelter). Parking is obviously an issue but I am most disturbed by the city's response to that concern to build a larger 3 story garage, making the site even bigger!! And also causing great disruption by paving over tennis courts, making road through garden and destroying garden plots. Instead of minimizing disruption to neighborhood this new plan is increasing the construction zone into surrounding area of park and garden and hurting our neighborhood. I am against the original proposed size and I am against the increasing the size and disruptiveness to community as an acceptable means to address the parking concerns.
