Dear Members of the Board:

On September 28, 2017, this office filed on behalf of Karla J. Etten, as co-Trustee for the Carol W Jaenicke Rev. Trust (u/d/t Nov. 21, 2013), a request for party status in the above-referenced matter.

On behalf of Ms. Etten in her above-referenced capacity as Trustee, this letter serves to withdraw such party status request and to note Ms. Etten's strong support for the application for the construction of a new lower/middle school and related improvements to accompany the existing high school on the Campus.

In the weeks intervening since our previous filing, Ms. Etten and the Applicant have had numerous productive discussions and email exchanges. The Applicant has revised plans for the application to accommodate each of Ms. Etten's concerns. These revisions include (i) relocating the driveway from the new parking garage that serves the new lower/middle school and (ii) agreeing to install noise-attenuating fencing and landscaping between the Campus and Ms. Etten's property. Ms. Etten is pleased that the now-vacant Safeway site will be put to a productive use and believes the proposed landscaping will beautify Ellicott Street and the surroundings. Ms. Etten is grateful that the Applicant has worked so hard to reach an agreement that is beneficial to all parties. Accordingly, Ms. Etten is now strongly in favor of the BZA



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approving the application.
