Application of B Monroe Ventures, LLC, pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle X, Chapter 10, for a variance from the side yard requirements of Subtitle E § 307.3, to construct a new three-story flat in the RF-1 zone at premises 1844 Monroe Street N.W. (Square 2614, Lot 38).

WHY YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS NOTICE

An Applicant in your neighborhood is seeking zoning relief for a project or use that is not allowed as a matter of right for the zoning district. The Zoning Regulations of the District of Columbia (Regulations) require such applicants to appear before the Board at a public hearing to make their case. The Regulations also require that notification of the public hearing be provided to property owners within 200 feet of the subject property indicated in the application, based on DC Office of Tax and Revenue records.
