#### REFERRAL MEMORANDUM AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

An Applicant within the boundaries of your ANC Single Member District is seeking zoning relief for a project or use that is not provided as a matter of right for the zoning district. This application was filed on October 9, 2017 through the Interactive Zoning Information System (IZIS).

A public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment (Board) on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>December 20, 2017 at 9:30 am</u>, at the Jerrily R. **Application of House of Ruth, Inc.,** pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle X, Chapter 9, for a special exception under Subtitle U § 203.1(g), to replace an existing child development center with a new facility and increase the number of children from 76 to 88 and the number of staff from 21 to 25 in the R-1-B and R-3 Zones at premises 2910 and 2916 Pennsylvania Avenue S.E. (Square 5546, Lots 800, 5, 6, 7, and 8).
