The ANC wishes to provide a sun-shade study, on behalf of residents, which will better show how the proposed addition will permanently degrade the sunlight to adjoining and adjacent properties. The applicant provided BZA a sun-shade study (Exhibit 52); however, their views use a 'parallel-projection' which minimize the impact. We believe the ANC-provided sun-shade study, which will use 'perspective views' will clearly show how existing residents would be unduly affected by the proposed addition.
