The revised CMP submitted by the MeGeehans does not state whether the construction process will require reserving parking spaces. Parking on our block is very limited.

If the proposed construction calls for reserving parking spaces, we should be informed in advance of:

- 1. how many parking spaces will be needed and/or reserved;
- 2. for how many hours each day they will be needed and/or reserved;
- 3. for how long a period reserved parking spaces will be required.

The plan calls for 7AM to 7 PM construction six days a week. Since the McGeehans will be moving out for much of this period, those of us who have to remain in our homes for the duration of their project need a thorough understanding of how we will be affected by the construction.
