An Applicant within 200 feet of your ANC boundary is seeking zoning relief for a project or use that is not provided as a matter of right for the zoning district. Notice is hereby given that the Board of Zoning Adjustment (Board) has scheduled this as an Expedited Review Calendar item and will therefore render a decision without public hearing on **Wednesday, June 13, 2018 at 9:30 am**, at the Jerrily R. Kress Memorial Hearing Room, One Judiciary Square, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C., 20001, on the following application:

Application of Lisa McGuire, pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle X, Chapter 9, for special exceptions under Subtitle E § 5201 from the lot occupancy requirements of Subtitle E § 304.1, the rear yard requirements of Subtitle E § 306.1, and the nonconforming structure requirements of Subtitle E § 202.2(b), to permit an existing nonconforming rear deck and balcony on an existing flat in the RF-1 Zone at premises 2825 11th Street N.W. (Square 2857, Lot 49).

Pursuant to Subtitle Y § 402.1, notice of public hearing is provided to ANCs within 200 feet of the property involved in the application; however, an ANC within 200 feet of the property is not an “affected ANC” unless the subject property is located on a street that serves as a boundary line between two ANCs.
