An individual, organization, or ANC is alleging an error in the determination or decision made by an administrative officer in the administration or enforcement of the Zoning Regulations of the District of Columbia (Regulations) regarding property within your ward's boundaries. This appeal was filed on <u>April 25, 2018</u> through the Interactive Zoning Information System (IZIS).

Appeal of Hilary Dove and Ranieri Cavaceppi, pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle Y § 302, from the determination made on April 6, 2018 by a Program Analyst in the Office of the Zoning Administrator, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, that the placement of three air conditioning compressor units in a side yard did not violate the side yard setback requirements and was not a cause for zoning enforcement action in the R-1-B Zone at premises 4400 Albemarle Street N.W. (Square 1590, Lot 43).
