DONALD C. RICHARDSON

Mr. Richardson is a graduate of Delaware Valley College and received a Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture (MLA) from Harvard University. Before joining the firm in 1961, he worked as a consultant to the Planning Board of Lexington, Massachusetts. He is past president of the New York Chapter, and a Fellow of the American Society of Landscape Architects. He is a registered Landscape Architect in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Connecticut and Massachusetts and a licensed Planner in the State of New Jersey. Mr. Richardson has served on the Association Council of the Harvard Graduate School of Design and as Adjunct Professor of Landscape Architecture at Rutgers University and the City University of New York. He has also served as Visiting Critic at Cornell University and Guest Lecturer at the School of Continuing Education in New York University and as Lecturer at Princeton University and the University of Pennsylvania School of Architecture. In 1973, he was appointed by Governor Cahill of New Jersey to a legislative commission to study State Land Use Policies and has served on the New Jersey State Board of Architects and Landscape Architects. Presently, he is a board member of the Regional Plan Association – New Jersey Committee, and a Trustee of Delaware Valley College. Mr. Richardson was a Planning Board Member for the township of Maplewood, NJ for 20 years.
