City Lights Trash Removal and Delivery Plan

Trash Removal

Presently, City Lights School disposes its trash in a dumpster located on the PUD site. After construction of the PUD, City Lights will return to the trash disposal method used when the school was originally operated as a Catholic school. At that time, there was a loading door on Todd Street, which opened onto a trash room. This door faced immediately onto First Street, N.E. (See photograph below). This allowed for a trash truck to back directly up to this door for pick up. Although these doors are currently bricked up, they will be restored with sliding doors. This is an improvement for City Lights since it allows trash to be emptied from the basement and not the 2nd floor, which due to the grade change, opens on to the existing parking lot.



Delivery Plan

City Lights has clarified that most of their food supplies are delivered by 30 foot trucks but they are occasionally serviced by larger trucks. Their suppliers have indicated that they can make all future deliveries in the smaller trucks. City Lights will have two options for supply delivery. They can take deliveries through the sliding doors installed on Todd Street or the supplies may be delivered through the proposed St. Martin Apartment's loading dock. Use of the sliding door is City Lights preferred method. Use of the loading dock would require the supplies to be carried by hand truck through the garage onto Todd Place and then into the adjacent sliding door.
