We are writing in support of ANC 3D's recommended modifications to the Sibley Hospital expansion plan. We recognize that Sibley provides valuable services, to this neighborhood among many others, but we also are acutely aware of the negative impact of its presence—even at present levels of activity.

Just recently, for example, a Sibley client driving a car with diplomatic plates parked across the driveway of a house in the 5800 block of Macarthur Boulevard. On returning to his car he showed no contrition when the homeowner remonstrated with him.

There are always going to be some cheapskates who are unwilling to pay the modest fees in Sibley's own lots. The number is bound to increase proportionately as the physical plant grows. The ANC's recommendations are a well thought-out effort to keep this problem within tolerable bounds, and we urge the Commission to accept them.
