

I am writing to express my support for the PUD and Zoning Map Amendment application for Sibley Hospital's proposed construction of a medical office building. I understand that the Zoning Commission has scheduled a hearing on February 1, 2007 on this application (Case No. 05-42). It is my belief that the addition of medical offices and accompanying parking proposed by Sibley will be an asset to the community and are an appropriate use for the site.

Sibley Hospital is a valuable asset to District residents, Ward 3 and the immediate Palisades community. Indeed, the hospital has worked closely with the community associations in the surrounding neighborhoods as well as ANC3D, and received their approval for the project. The hospital has also been an important medical resource for DC residents.
