The District Department of Transportation has been asked to respond to an inquiry from Mr. George Oberlander regarding Sibley Hospital compliance with Zoning Order 16654 concerning transportation elements.

We have reviewed the Zoning Order and find that Sibley Hospital is in substantial compliance. Several of the elements in the Zoning Order are addressed through the hospital's pending Zoning Commission Case 05-42.

### **Bus Boarding and Layover Bays**

Sibley Hospital has conducted extensive discussions with DDOT and WMATA regarding use of Little Falls Road and we are in continuing conversations on use of Little Falls Road for bus layover uses.

### **Loughboro Road Bus Stop**

DDOT acknowledges that the relocation of the bus stop at the intersection of Loughboro Road and Dalecarlia Parkway to the bus layover lane. DDOT will judge whether the bus stop relocation to the bus layover lane is necessary upon completion of the Sibley MOB construction.

### **Eliminate bus stop on residential side of the Loughboro Road**

DDOT and WMATA do not support this recommendation.
