PETITION REGARDING CONTINUED SIBLEY HOSPITAL EXPANSION

As an immediate neighbor of Sibley Memorial Hospital, I agree that the Hospital should take action to remedy the impact of its construction and expansion on the residential character of our neighborhood. These actions include:

of the oncology facilities

- Re-routing buses: Facilitate and where necessary, meet the costs for re-routing buses to Little Falls Road.
- Landscaping: Screen all parking lots and the nursing facility.
- Loughboro Road nursing facility entrance: Erect "No Left Turn" sign from entrance; prohibit service and employee vehicles from using this entrance.
- Exterior lighting: Work with the neighbors and community to reduce night-time impact of exterior institutional lighting.
- "Campus" plan requirement: I support changing D.C. law to require long-term site plans for all significant institutional landowners and request the Hospital to voluntarily comply in the meantime.

When firm commitments to these actions are made, I would support the variance currently before the D.C. Board of Zoning Adjustment for an expanded oncology treatment center. I understand this petition will be submitted to the Advisory Neighborhood Commission and become a public record.
