Dear Ms. Mitten,

We live at 5001 Loughboro Road which is at the intersection of Millwood. We strongly oppose the exemption from zoning requirements requested by Sibley Hospital.

There is no sidewalk on our side of Loughboro Road. When we leave our house on foot to take a walk or catch a bus at Ward Circle we have to cross Loughboro carefully in between gaps in the traffic. We live below Arizona so, except for rush hour, it is not too much of a problem. However, with increased traffic it will be impossible.

No one is able to park on Loughboro within 25 yards of our entrance due to a bus stop and driveways. When guests come to visit they usually park on Millwood and then walk across Loughboro. If they park on Loughboro it is not possible to walk to our house except in the street.

The increase on traffic will not only be dangerous it will severely adversely affect the value of our property. We urge you to deny the exemption.
