This letter is to express my strong support for the PUD and Zoning Map amendment application regarding Sibley Hospital's proposed construction of a medical office building.


I am a resident of Spring Valley West for several years. Also, I am currently the President of the Spring Valley West Homes Corporation representing 157 homes in the neighborhood north of Sibley hospital with boundaries on Dalecarlia Parkway NW.

I believe the addition of a medical office building to the Sibley Hospital campus will provide significant benefits to the residents of the entire community. I further believe that the proposed use of the new medical building, i.e. doctors' offices, related medical uses as an x-ray clinic, blood bank and pharmacy is entirely consistent with medical services already provided at Sibley Hospital

Along with many of my neighbors, I want to see Sibley Hospital continue to thrive at its current site and look forward to the on-site convenience and accessibility of a medical office facility and its related services.
