
Dear Ms. Cooper:

This letter confirms our discussions with Michael Thomas of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A that WB/NV Center City Hotel Holdings, LLC, commits to contributing \$462,000.00 to the D.C. Public Libraries Foundation for the benefit of the West End Branch Library as a benefit of our proposed Planned Unit Development at 1143 New Hampshire Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. We understand that the funds will be used exclusively as follows: the design, development and installation of a computer lab at the West End Branch Library, including the cost of space build-out, acquisition of computers and computer stations, and related office equipment and furniture; and the design, development and build-out of facilities for community and civic organizations, including furniture; and the necessary power and lighting modifications to accommodate the added facilities. To the extent feasible, the improvements paid for by this money will be movable.

This contribution is being made as a community benefit of our PUD and the funds will be released prior to issuance of the certificate of occupancy that will allow us to use the new space in our expanded hotel. We agree to enter into any necessary Memorandum of Understanding with the D.C. Public Library and the D.C. Public Library Foundation to effectuate the contribution and release of the funds.

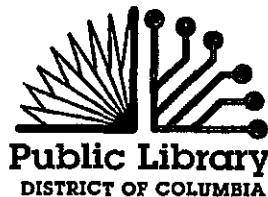


