Enterprise Community Partners strongly supports the approval of the Consolidated PUD and Related Map Amendment for the Linda Joy and Kenneth Jay Pollin Memorial Community development in northeast Washington DC

The Washington Metropolitan area now stands as one of the nation's strongest regional economies. This prosperity has generated tremendous opportunities and challenges. Home prices and rents are rising faster than incomes creating serious hardship for working families. Demand for high end housing and an active for profit development community contribute to significant housing production at all levels driving up land prices and fueling gentrification and displacement. The redevelopment of the two parcels in the subject Consolidated PUD application in the Parkside Neighborhood of Ward 7 will not only help to stabilize the community it will also bring 125 new affordable housing units to a community in need of revitalization. Affordable rental and homeownership opportunities have become more difficult for low income families to locate in all neighborhoods in the city given the high housing costs today. This development is an important investment and opportunity for the District

Another important item to note is that the developer will be utilizing Enterprise's Green Communities grant for the construction of the units. Green Communities is the first national green building program focused entirely on affordable housing. It incorporates many innovations from the mainstream' green building movement including the use of environmentally sustainable materials reduction of environmental impact and increased energy efficiency. Green Communities takes the idea of green several steps further emphasizing design and materials that safeguard the health of residents and siting that provides close easy access to public transportation, schools, and services
