Review and approval of a consolidated planned unit development and related map amendment from the R-4, R-5-A, and C-M-1 Zone Districts to the R-5-A, C-2-B, and C-M-1 Zone Districts. This application also includes an amendment to the University's Campus Plan to remove the subject property from the jurisdiction of the Campus Plan. The property is located in the northeastern quadrant of the District and known as Lots 4-6, 10, 12, 15-17, 801-806, and 811 in Square 3654; Lot 1 in Square 3655; Lot 800 in Square 3656, Lots 805, 821, and 826 in Square 3657; and Lot 818 in Square 3831.
