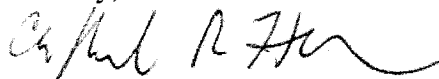

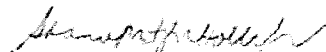
As a resident of Georgetown, I would appreciate your giving my views equal consideration to those being expressed by people who are opposed to the plan.
