I am writing regarding the Georgetown University Campus Plan Case No. 10-32. I support Georgetown University's Campus Plan and am adamantly opposed to requiring Georgetown University to house 100% of its undergraduate students on-campus by the fall of 2016.

The legality of requiring Georgetown to house 100% of its undergraduate students on-campus is very questionable. Under the DC Human Rights Act, students are a protected class of citizens.
