- The beds on campus number assumes the Southwest Quadrangle is fully occupied in Fall 2003. The number of students housed on campus assumes all beds are occupied.
- In Spring 2000, 84 percent of the undergraduate students living off campus lived in Zip Code 20007 and 16 percent lived elsewhere in Washington, D.C., Virginia or Maryland (calculated using numbers provided by the University). **The Office of Planning used those same percentages** (84 and 16 percent) to show how students living off campus **might be distributed** in Zip Code 20007 and elsewhere in the city and suburbs in 2003 and 2010 if the percentages remained the same (percentages and calculated numbers shown in *italics*). The actual number living in Zip Code 20007 in 2003 and 2010 could be lower or higher.
