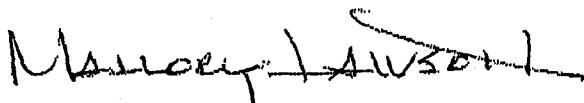
Dear Zoning Commission Members:

My name is (Ms.) Mallory Lawson and I live at 1615 44th Street, in the Foxhall Village Community. I have owned this home for 13 years and am hoping to stay even longer. I would like to be on record as opposing the Loop Road proposed by Georgetown University.

As you probably know, DC traffic is already the worst in the nation I encounter the bottle-neck of the University traffic every single day on either Canal Road, Reservoir Road, or both. Sometimes it takes a half an hour to go 1.3 miles to get to Key Bridge.
