RE: Opposition to Georgetown University Campus Plan 2010-2020, Case No. 10-32

My wife and I have been residents of Foxhall Village, living at 1605 – 44th Street, NW, which I have owned for the past 42 years. I am alarmed at the prospect of Georgetown University building a “loop road” adjacent to Glover Archbold Park which abuts my townhouse.

Such a road would impact negatively on my view and enjoyment of the park, especially in winter when there are no leaves on the trees to help obscure the proposed roadway. The noise from traffic would be quite audible and annoying (I can already hear traffic noise from the existing university/hospital service road adjacent to the park). The potential for small landslides into the park has already been demonstrated. In short, a loop road would have a significantly negative impact on the adjacent parkland and potentially reduce my property value.

I hope the Commission will recognize the adverse effects of such a project and refuse to approve it.
