The Burleith 2000 survey only counted undergraduate houses. This included a mixed house that housed undergraduates and graduates combined.

2000	114 undergraduate student group rental houses
2010	<u>127</u> undergraduates student group rental houses

13 student group rental house increase

We noted during our testimony that the streets of 37th, S and 38 St were adversely impacted. One only has to read the 2000 reports and testimony of the Office of Planning and Bolan Associates to see the adverse impacts that we still live with and the successful remedies that were predicted but didn't happen. So what was a bad situation in 2000 has become worse not better, as GU predicted. Accordingly we need to deal with the underlying problem which is not the 11% increase in undergraduate group houses but the total number of undergraduate houses at the present time, to which must added 38 graduate group houses from our survey.
