Dear Zoning Commissioners:

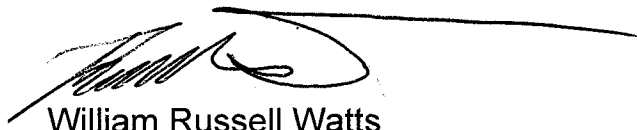
