I have lived in the neighborhood, same
house since 1968, and am grateful to be
a neighbor of Georgetown University.

The University, in my view, has been
a good neighbor offering employment,

Over the many years I have attended
Foxhall Citizens meetings I am dismayed by
the history of opposition and vitriol
towards the school and its plans.

I left the Citizens meetings for over
20 years because of that and recently
returned to the same total opposition
to the 10 year plan.

* There is irony that now the Citizens
association wants all entrance + exits to the
University to be at the Canal Road exit.

For years they ^{opposed} this — and today
it proves to counter all the concerns. It works.

Also, regarding the proposed loop road for buses,
I suggest you visit the alley behind the
44th Street Foxhall Village Houses —

Observe that the road can't even be
seen in the winter woods and also

note the gardens and use of park land
by the home owners bordering the alley

and park land. * See map on TV case —
No righteous indignation here.
