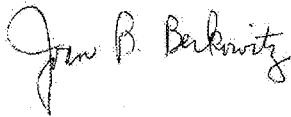
Dear Zoning Commissioners:

I am writing to request, in no uncertain terms, that the Commission deny Georgetown University's request for a continuance of the hearing scheduled for this evening.

Georgetown University has had plenty of time to develop a credible transportation plan. The Commission has been more than fair in providing all parties with ample opportunity to review the plan and to testify. I have attended every hearing in person. I did not testify, but my next door neighbor at 1938 35th Street did. Like her, I have not experienced the horrors documented by others who live closer to Georgetown University, but like her as well, I strongly support my neighbors in opposing the GU plan. The plan calls for increased tuition revenue from increased enrolment without incurring the additional cost of providing adequate on-campus housing. The result can only be further expansion of the blight to other areas of Burleith, including my block.

Allowing GU to delay until fall the submission of yet another revised transportation plan is a waste of the Commission's time and an insult to the community.
