Dear Chairman Hood:

The Citizens Association of Georgetown and the Burleith Citizens' Association are opposed to the request from counsel for Georgetown University ("GU") that the Commission continue the hearing scheduled for Monday, June 20, 2011 to September 19, 2011 and DDOT's suggestion that the hearing be scheduled in October. Although GU has had years to prepare its campus plan and transportation analysis it did not file its Campus Plan until the day before its existing Plan expired on December 31, 2010. That Plan had many deficiencies which have been identified by the Office of Planning, the Department of Transportation and the parties.

While GU's transportation plan remains deficient six months later for the reasons set forth in DDOT's Supplemental Report dated June 14, 2011, and the submissions of ANC 2E and the parties, the Commission can separate transportation issues from all other issues raised by the Campus Plan and address those issues in October.

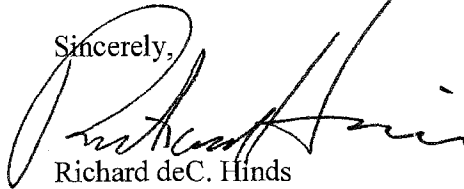

The University's adverse impacts on traffic and parking availability in the surrounding communities, while important to address effectively, are not the most important issues in this Campus Plan proceeding. The principal issues are GU's failure to provide adequate housing for its growing undergraduate and graduate enrollment and the serious, objectionable conditions that have been created in Burlieth and West Georgetown as a result. An extensive delay in addressing those issues is harmful to the community and should be avoided if at all possible.

CAG and BCA therefore respectfully request that the Commission conclude its hearing on June 20 on non-transportation issues, and set a schedule for the preparation of proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law on those issues by the parties.

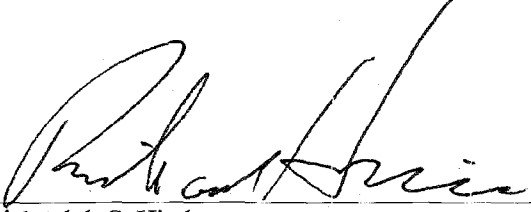
