These petitions in opposition to GU's "loop road" plan were circulated from May 15, 2011 to June 19, 2011 along the east side of 44th Street, NW, houses with backs to Glover-Archbold Park and two houses at the east end of P St NW that has a dead end at the park. These houses are the most directly impacted by the GU "Loop Road" plan to construct a bus thoroughfare along the border of the park.

A total of 40 of the 46 houses where occupants could be reached (87%) signed the petition opposing the loop road proposed in the 10-year GU Campus plan. Only 2 households (4%) explicitly were against the petition.

Total of houses contacted, 62.

Total houses where occupant signed, 40.

Total houses where there was no answer, 16.

*Total houses where occupant would not sign, 5.

Total houses where occupant was uncommitted, 1.

* Occupant at one house said they didn't have enough information to sign; Occupant at two houses said they were moving and didn't want to influence the issue; occupants at two other houses did not want to sign.

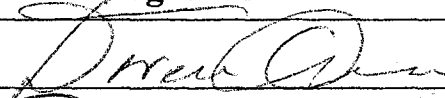
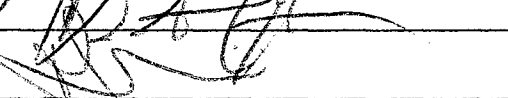
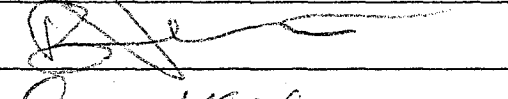
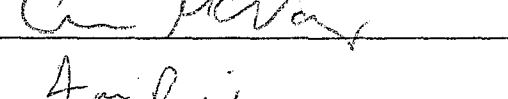
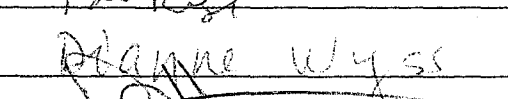
Petition to Protect Glover Archbold Park from Georgetown University's Proposed Bus Road

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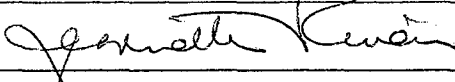
Georgetown University (GU) proposes to build a bus road along the eastern rim of Glover Archbold Park, which is a National park and urban treasure in the District of Columbia. If approved, the bus road will become the route for hundreds of buses a day. GU's plan calls for the road to be built on the eastern ridge of the park, which has collapsed twice in several years. The plan requires a stand of mature trees to be removed as well as significant re-grading of the slope. The bus traffic will pollute the park with noise, light, and exhaust. We, the undersigned, neighbors and concerned citizens, oppose GU's plan to construct and operate a road for bus traffic along the eastern ridge of Glover Archbold Park.
