Dear Chairman Hood and Members of the Commission:

At the last hearing in this case on June 20, 2011, the issue of interim relief was raised but the subject was deferred to the hearing schedule for November 17, 2011 (June 20 transcript, p. 20, 49-52). Since Georgetown University ("GU") did not file its Campus Plan until December 30, 2010, it has been operating without a new Campus Plan in effect. GU, the Office of Planning ("OP") and the parties in opposition are all in agreement that there need to be caps on undergraduate and total student enrollment on campus. However, since there are no graduate student or "nontraditional" undergraduate student caps at the present time, GU might legally enroll more students than the OP and the parties in opposition believe is appropriate and consistent with applicable law. Accordingly, the Citizens Association of Georgetown ("CAG") and the Burleith Citizens Association ("BCA") respectfully requests that the Commission impose the following interim enrollment caps effective Fall 2012:

Traditional Undergraduate Enrollment: 6,652, as proposed by the OP in its Report dated May 5, 2011, and the same as GU's Fall 2010 enrollment.

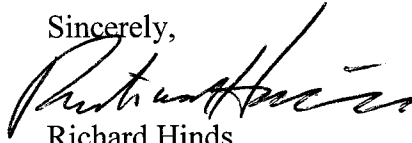

Maximum Total Enrollment: 14,000, about the same as GU's Fall 2010 enrollment of 14,033. [Note that about 200 students actually enrolled at GU's Clarendon, VA Campus were included in GU's 14,033 figure. See April 14, 2011, ZC Transcript at p. 249-250]

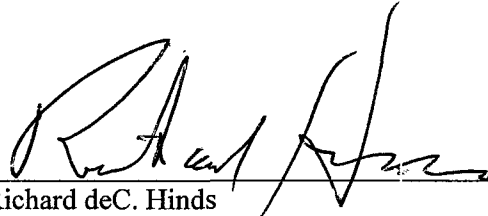
