

GEORGETOWN COMPLIANCE WITH 2000 CAMPUS PLAN CONDITIONS

2000 Plan Condition	Status	Comments
<u>Undergraduate enrollment</u> : "The Applicant shall not increase undergraduate enrollment above the cap of 6,016."	Full compliance	For academic year 2009-2010, the number of undergraduate students was 5,921; for academic year 2010-2011, the number was 5,919. No increase sought in 2010 Plan.
<u>Off-campus mitigation</u> : "The Applicant shall implement and enforce programs....designed to mitigate any adverse impacts associated with students living off-campus in the neighborhoods in the vicinity of the campus."	Full compliance	GU has enhanced the off-campus student life program each year; now includes additional SNAP patrols, MPD detail, new policies and enforcement for off-campus students and landlord initiatives
<u>Large event scheduling</u> : "The Applicant shall avoid scheduling events that attract large numbers of visitors to the campus during peak traffic times of 7 to 9am and 4 to 7pm...and shall employ campus personnel as necessary to direct visitors to campus parking areas" relating to weekday evening events at the Performing Arts Center and Athletic events.	Full compliance	
<u>Parking</u> : "The Applicant shall maintain a parking inventory of no more than 4,080 off-street parking spaces within the campus boundary."	Full compliance	No increase sought in 2010 Plan.

Transportation Management: “The Applicant shall enhance its Transportation Management Program so as to promote greater transit usage, including increased ridership of GUTS bus service and to work with the community, MedStar and the DPW as part of a cooperative effort to look at mitigation strategies for Reservoir Road.

Full compliance

DDOT commended GU for its transportation management program. GUTS bus ridership doubled to 2 million from 2000 to 2010.

Revised Campus Plan: “The Applicant shall prepare a revised campus plan that is consistent with this Order, accompanied by a table of changes that lists each change.”
