

QUARTERLY MEETINGS WITH THE COMMUNITY

As a condition of its approval of the University's 1990 Campus Plan, the Board of Zoning Adjustment mandated that the University meet on a quarterly basis with all community groups surrounding its campus. Although the BZA did not include that condition in the University's 2000 Campus Plan, the University has voluntarily continued the quarterly meetings as an opportunity for the community and the University to exchange information and to promote dialogue. MedStar is also a participant at these meetings. The invited community members include:

ANC Commissioners for 2E, 3B, 3C and 3D

Citizens Associations for Burleith, Georgetown, Foxhall, Hillandale, Cloisters, Palisades and Glover Park.

There are no minutes taken at these meetings which are intended to promote open dialogue. Agendas are prepared in advance, however, with input from all participants. All members of the group also take turns hosting the meeting.

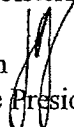

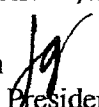
