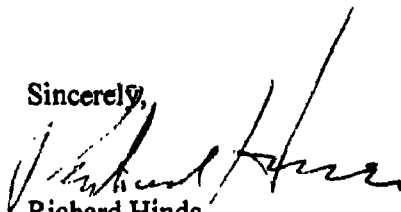

Dear Chairman Hood and Members of the Commission:

By letter dated November 8, 2011, the Citizens Association of Georgetown ("CAG"), the Burleith Citizens Association ("BCA") and ANC 2E requested interior relief in the form of enrollment caps (Exs. 343, 346). On December 15, 2011 Georgetown University responded with a proposal to the Commission's request that the University voluntarily agree to an undergraduate cap and a maximum cap until an order is issued.
