

EXHIBIT K MAIN CAMPUS STUDENT HEADCOUNT

Under the 2010 Campus Plan, Georgetown University will, for the first time, adopt an agreed-upon maximum on overall Main Campus student enrollment (covering graduate and undergraduate students), to be coupled with an agreement to maintain undergraduate enrollment at currently-permitted levels, as described in Exhibit L. As illustrated below, the voluntary Main Campus maximum is based on the number of students registered for a course based at the Main Campus, and will be calculated each semester.

I. Headcount

The Fall 2010 Main Campus student headcount was 13,387 students, derived from the official University statistics as set forth below.

The proposed agreed-upon maximum Main Campus student headcount is 14,106 students based on the same methodology set forth below. Growth will be largely in graduate student programs and will be gradual and measured.

II. Methodology

The proposed methodology for determining the “Main Campus Student Headcount” starts with the total number of students reported under the Integrated Postsecondary Education Database System (IPEDS), which is established by the National Center for Education Statistics, a division of the U.S. Department of Education.¹ All postsecondary institutions that participate in federal student financial aid programs, like Georgetown, must report to IPEDS using standardized data definitions and parameters. The IPEDS number, therefore, counts the Georgetown University total student body.

To determine “Main Campus Student Headcount,” the total number reported under IPEDS is reduced by the number of students (by headcount) who are not registered for any courses located at the Main Campus. Examples of students who are not registered for any courses located at the Main Campus include:

- Students who are registered for courses located only at off-campus locations (such as the Law Center, SFS-Qatar, and other locations not at the Main Campus);
- Students studying abroad; and
- Continuous registration students.

As of Fall 2012, students enrolled in the senior citizen auditor program are also exempt from the Main Campus Student Headcount.

The official count of the Georgetown University total student body is taken in the Fall semester on the census date for purposes of its IPEDS reporting. Each Fall, the University will calculate the Main Campus Student Headcount as of the census date. The University will also conduct a second count in the Spring semester using the same methodology. For the Spring semester, enrollment headcounts will be calculated on a date reasonably determined by the University to reflect the maximum undergraduate enrollment for that semester.

This proposed methodology is predicated on federally-defined and federally-required reported enrollment statistics, and appropriately subtracts students not located on Main Campus.

III. Application of the Main Campus Student Headcount

Table 1, below, illustrates the application of the proposed methodology to the University's enrollment statistics through the calculation of the Main Campus Student Headcount for the Fall 2010, Fall 2011, and Fall 2012 semesters.
