**Re: Z.C. Case No. 10-32 – Georgetown University Campus Plan
Response to Requests for Extension of Time and
Clarification of Order of Presentation**

Dear Chairman Hood and Members of the Commission:

Georgetown University supports the request from OP and DDOT to extend the deadline for filing reports, and supports the request from the agencies, ANC 2E and 3D to schedule the presentation of their testimony for the May 12, 2011 public hearing date. The extension will permit these entities an opportunity to fully consider the substantial and meaningful modifications that Georgetown proposed in its prehearing submission.

Georgetown would like to confirm, however, that the University will proceed with its direct presentation on April 14, 2011. The University's President, Dr. DeGioia, is a key witness in that presentation, and has arranged his schedule to be available for April 14. Accordingly, the University would like to go forward with its direct presentation on April 14 so that Dr. DeGioia can participate in the hearing process. (Due to scheduling constraints, Dr. DeGioia will not be available to participate on May 12 or May 16.)

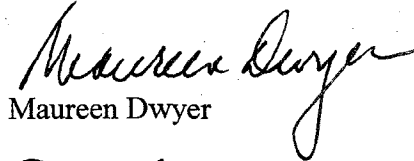

Finally, Georgetown also agrees that the regular order of presentation should be preserved through the hearing process. Accordingly, should the Commission agree to postpone testimony from the agencies and ANC's to the May 12 hearing date, then the April 14 hearing will consist solely of preliminary matters, the University's direct presentation, and questions and cross-examination from the Zoning Commission, ANC's, and parties. The hearing would then resume on May 12 with OP and DDOT's presentations, followed by the ANC's and then testimony by parties, persons and organizations in support and opposition.

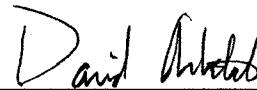
