Dear Chairman Hood and Members of the Commission:

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We understand that the DC Office of Planning (OP) and the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) have requested today that their positions in the Z.C. Case No. 10-31 (Georgetown University Campus Plan 2010-2020) be filed on May 7, rather than today, and their presentation take place at the hearing scheduled for May 12.

We believe their reasons are good ones for making this request. Georgetown University filed voluminous new material only recently. The parties need time to examine and respond to this new information. Both the Citizens Association of Georgetown (CAG) and the Burleith Citizens Association (BCA) need this time as well. We also need to have the OP and DDOT reports in hand as a foundation for our presentation.

We respectfully request, therefore, that the Zoning Commission adhere to the regular order of presentation so that the CAG and BCA information follows that of OP and DDOT on May 12. The April 14 hearing would then focus on a presentation by Georgetown University, cross-examination related to that presentation, and presentations by any individuals in support of the applicant's position. Presentations by OP, DDOT, CAG and BCA could then proceed in the regular order beginning May 12.
